Feasibility

Project Based Learning

Project Based Learning allows students to gain knowledge and skills by working for an extended period to investigate and respond to an engaging and complex question, problem, or challenge.

5 keys to rigorous problem solving

- Real World Connection-Authentic Problem
- Effective Learning - Through the Project
- Structured Collaboration
- Student Driven: Teachers become facilitators, and students take control. As facilitators, teachers need to ask good questions and redirect the students, if necessary.
- Multifaceted Assessment - This includes in-between assessment and formative assessments. Students should also be able to assess themselves.

Experiential Learning

Experiential Learning is a process through which students develop knowledge, skills, and values from direct experiences outside a traditional academic setting.

Experiential Learning follows a process of

- ACT (Concrete Experience)
- APPLY (Reflexive Observation)
- REFLECT (Abstract Conceptualization)
- CONCEPTUALIZE (Practical Application)

Activity Based Learning

Activity Based Learning (ABL) is a subset of Experiential Learning where students learn at their own pace through teacher-facilitated exercises.

The core premise of ABL is based on doing some hands-on experiments and activities. The idea of ABL is rooted in the common notion that students are active learners rather than passive recipients of information. If they are provided the opportunity to explore on their own along with an optimum learning environment, then the learning becomes joyful and long-lasting.

Blended Learning

Blended Learning is an education program (formal or informal) that combines online digital media with traditional classroom methods. It requires the physical presence of both teacher and student, with some element of student control over time, place, path, or pace.

While students still attend "brick-and-mortar" schools with a teacher present, face-to-face classroom practices are combined with computer-mediated activities regarding content and delivery. Blended Learning is also used in professional development and training settings.

Flipped Classroom

The Flipped Classroom is a pedagogical model in which the typical lecture and homework elements of a course are reversed. Short video lectures are viewed by students at home before the class session, while in-class time is devoted to exercises, projects, or discussions. The video lecture is often seen as the key ingredient in the flipped approach, such lectures being either created by the instructor and posted online or selected from an online repository.

While a pre-recorded lecture could certainly be a podcast or other audio format, the ease with which video can be accessed and viewed today has made it so ubiquitous that the flipped model has come to be identified with it.

Scenerio Based Learning / Contextual Learning

Scenario Based Learning (SBL) uses interactive scenarios to support active learning strategies such as problem-based or case-based learning. It normally involves students working their way through a storyline, usually based around an ill-structured or complex problem, which they are required to solve.

Storytelling

Storytelling is an activity that can transfer emotions and feelings, and also can boost thinking capacity. It involves the conveying of events in words, sound and/or images, often by improvisation or embellishment. Stories or narratives have been shared in every culture as a means of entertainment, education, cultural preservation, and instilling moral values. Storytelling is an art that has mental, social and educational benefits for students

Play

Learning through play is a term used in education and psychology to describe how a student can learn to make sense of the world around them. Through play, students can develop social and cognitive skills, mature emotionally, and gain the self-confidence required to engage in new experiences and environments.

Key ways that young students learn include playing, being with other people, being active, exploring new experiences, talking to themselves, communication with others, meeting physical and mental challenges, being shown how to do new things, practicing and repeating skills and having fun.

Gamification of Learning

Game Design is the art of applying design and aesthetics to create a game to facilitate interaction between players for playful, healthful, educational, or simulation purposes. Game Design can be applied both to games and to other interactions, particularly virtual ones.



Foundation Year

The Foundation Program is a unique and exclusive feature built on the philosophy of liberal education. It provides an opportunity to broaden the perspective of learning by creative thinking and experimentation. Being a common program for students of all streams, it aims at building the creative, analytical, social and individual skills required to excel in the chosen fields. There are also a set of distinct courses for all the domains which aim at building skills deemed essential for the core courses which are selected in the succeeding year.

The students work on a wide variety of projects, indulge in social and industry immersions, and understand the entrepreneurial spirit through various industry connect activities. This exposure creates a platform to learn and grow which in turn facilitates the selection of desired fields at the end of the program.

The Foundation Program is considered to be the most crucial part of these professional courses. It gives students the freedom to ideate and develop the skill of creative problem-solving. The learners extensively explore, collaborate, create and are continuously assessed by domain-leaders who let them carve their own journey through expert guidance and ice-breaking sessions.

ASSESSMENT

Assessment at Avantika is based on the performance of the student as a process, and not as an event

The performance of a student in a course is assessed through a series of ContinuousComprehensiveEvaluation(CCE)andCourseEndAssessment (CEA), as per the requirements and nature of individual courses.

The Continuous Comprehensive Evaluation (CCE) may consist of closed/open book examination, quizzes, portfolio generation, assignments, problem solving, programming, prototyping, field work, projects, or any other innovative assessment practices followed by the faculty. The Course End Assessment (CEA) may be in the form of an external Jury or closed/open book written examination.

FABLAB

The FAB Lab at Avantika is a state-of-the-art lab consisting of high-end digital fabrication and manufacturing machinery consisting of an array of flexible computer-controlled tools, that cover several different length scales and various materials, with the aim to make "almost anything" and cater a platform for new ideas and innovation.

Wood Shop



The Wood Shop is a place where the students explore the fundamentals of woodwork and carpentry getting deep insight into the use of Timber. Students make use of hand and power tools to develop various joineries and products by performing planing, sawing and chiselling operations. The Wood Shop includes Wood Lathe, Band Saw, Jig Saw, Single Bevel Mitre, Surface Planer Cum Thickness Wood Planer.

Metal Shop



The Metal Shop is a place where the students explore working with metal to design, develop and fabricate various products through operations like Cylindrical Turning, Step Turning, Taper Turning, Facing, Cutting, Milling, Chamfering, Drilling, Reaming. The Metal Shop includes Lathe Machine, Milling Machine, Drilling Machine, Bench Grinder, Pipe Bending Machine, Metal Cutter 1100W, Metal Shear 1.6, Nibbler 1.6, and Kit of Forming tools etc.

Welding Shop



Welding Shop is a place where the students perform arc welding fusion processes for joining metals. The different operations practiced by students in Welding Shop are Position Welding, Butt Welding, Lap Welding, Spot Welding, etc. The Welding Shop includes ARC+ Tig Welding Machine with safety equipments.

Fitting Shop



The Fitting Shop is a place where the students refine their products to achieve desired shapes, size and accuracy, through various finishing operations such as marking, filing, chipping, sawing, scraping, drilling, reaming, tapping, threading and grinding etc. The Fitting Shop includes, Machine Vice, Bench and Hand Drill Machine, Angle Grinder 540W with Angle Polisher Attachment, and various files etc.

Plastic Shop



Plastic Shop is a place where students learn to turn plastic into permanent objects such as protective covers by identifying and acquainting with suitable materials. Students learn to design wood, machined aluminum molds, which are used to develop different shapes with the use of vacuum forming machines.

Paint Shop



The Paint Shop is a place where students give surface treatment to their prototypes or models with the aim to give a final finish to their products. Students work with water and solvent-based paints, varnishes, various surface treatment agents, oils and waxes for this process using paint spraying booths.

Industrial Mind Restoration

IMR is a platform for our learners to step out of the campus and learn by observation in a real business environment. This is facilitated by a visit to manufacturing companies, design houses or city tours. The sessions are designed for exploration of business processes, operational styles and industry practices.

Avantika Innovation and Incubation Center

The Avantika Innovation and Incubation Center (AIIC) aims to create an entrepreneurial ecosystem on the campus that can facilitate connections and speed up innovative ideas from concept to reality. The team assists student incubatees in creating a sustainable, scalable, and profitable business model by developing the culture of growth-oriented entrepreneurship through boot camps, training, mentorship, facilitating investments, and connecting to a strong network of mentors or investors who would provide sector-specific knowledge and real-world practical guidance. Every year, the team forges partnerships and networks with academia, industry, funding sources, existing incubators, and others for the start-ups to leverage.

MIT Pune's Ujjain campus, Avantika University's 2 students, Aditya Upadhyay and Sagar Manjhi selected for startup grant support under Yukti Innovation Challenge (YIC) organized by Ministry of Education's Innovation Cell and AICTE for their respective startups. Aditya Upadhyay received Rs. 7 lakhs grant for his project "PET-Fil" and Sagar Manjhi received Rs. 4 lakhs grant for his project "Panipuri Piercing Machine".

This grant is provided for Startups which focus on innovation and to develop their idea. 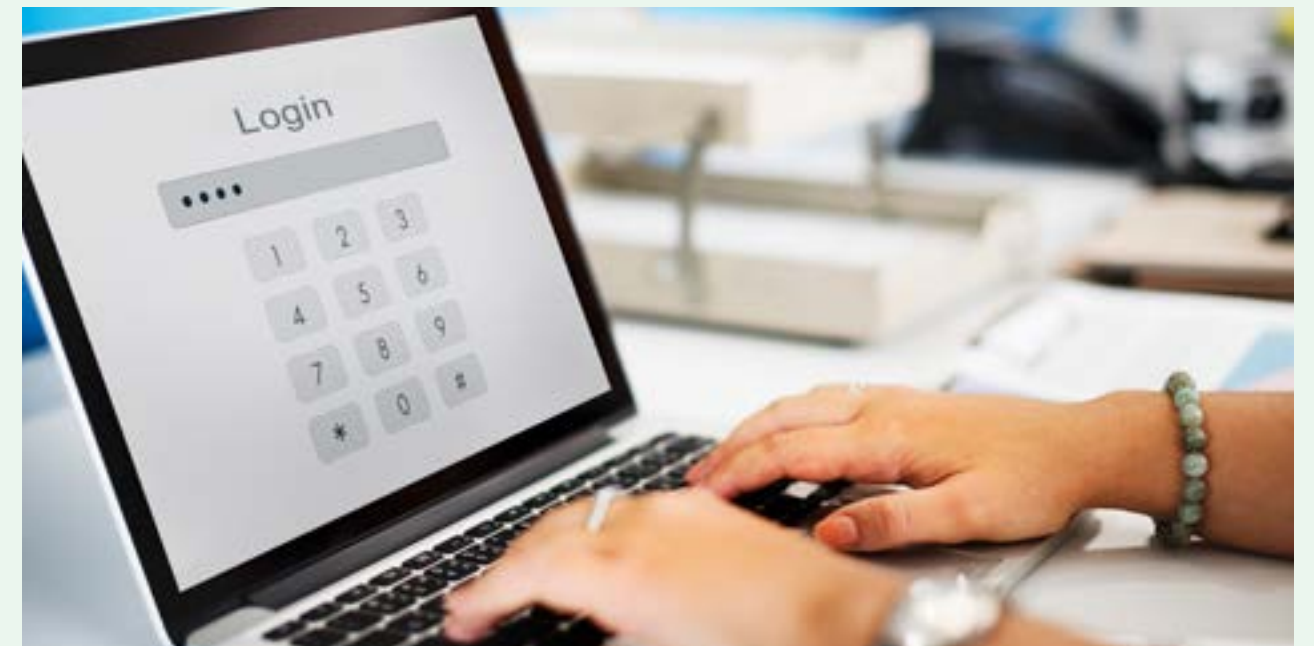
Course Registration

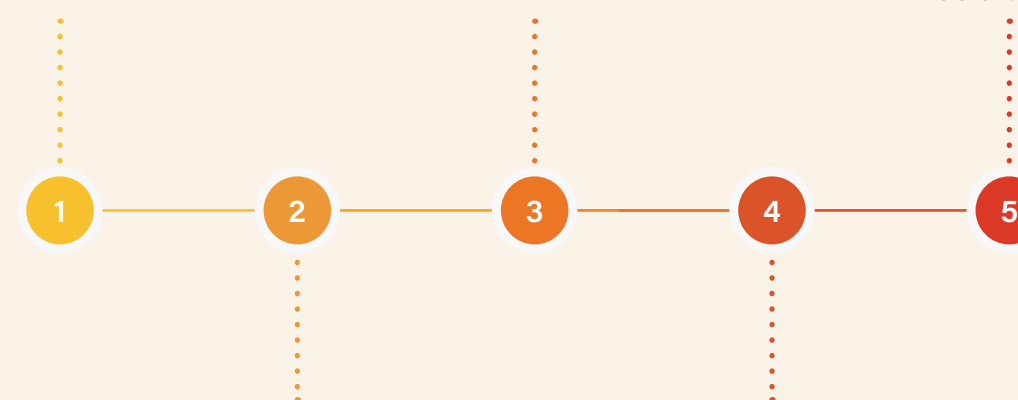

Disciplinary Procedures and Rules

Appeal and Hearing Process (AHP) at Avantika University

All alleged violations of rules and regulations of the university would be resolved by this process. The implementation may vary from case to case, and depend on the severity and intensity of the violation. The process consists of the following steps:

- Report of the event/ activity to the grievance cell.
- Preparation of initial enquiry report by grievance cell.
- Depending on the initial enquiry, the university or reporter may decide to resolve the issue by informal counseling of member(s) involved.
- In some cases, the university may recommend a grievance committee hearing process with both parties.

Confidentiality

Avantika University understands and respects individual rights. All aspects of AHP are maintained private and all participants (reporter and respondent), and members of the investigation and hearing committee in an AHP will be informed that confidentiality should be strictly followed in order to enhance the integrity of the investigation.

Students Rights

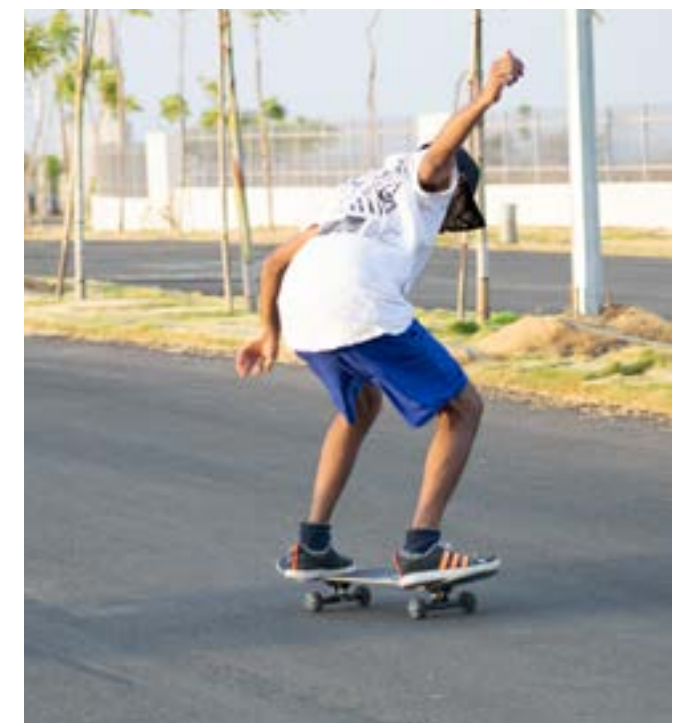
- Students' private information will not be shared or released to persons outside the university, without prior permission of students.

Mandu Fort - Dhar

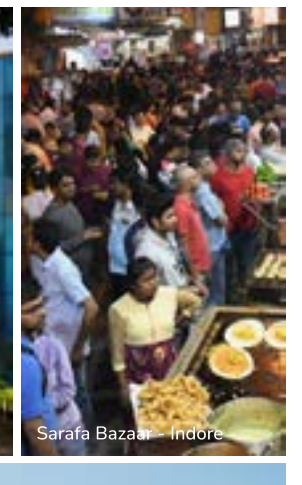
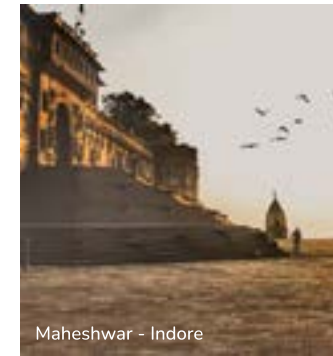

Reaching Avantika



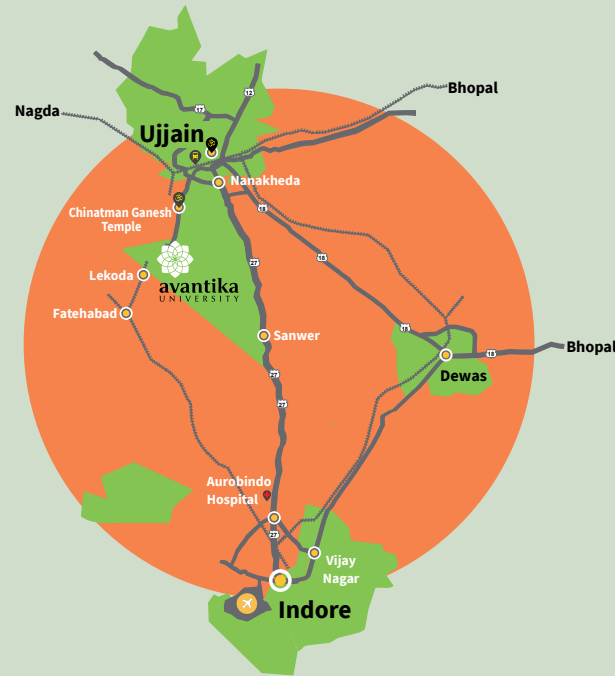
The closest airport is Devi Ahilyabai Holkar Domestic Airport at Indore. The busiest airport in Madhya Pradesh, it is well connected to most major Indian cities. The University is 55 km from the Indore Airport.



The railway stations at Ujjain and Indore have direct connectivity of trains from Delhi, Mumbai and other major cities of India. The railway station at Ujjain is 14 km (8 miles) from the campus, and the one at Indore is 50 km from the campus.
